The Ngāti Tama ki Te Tau Ihu Cultural Trustees wish to extend a warm invitation to all our lwi whānau to join us to celebrate and mark the successful completion of our Treaty settlement with the Crown, and to wananga together as proud Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu. The Wananga will be held from 4pm Friday 2 January until 3pm Sunday 4 January 2015 at Onetahua Marae in Mohua (Golden Bay). Powhiri will be at 4.30pm.

Sunday 4 January Time to Hui, korero and learn the stories of Onetahua, pack up, clean up,

poroporoaki farewells.

providing your own kai, and cleaning facilities prior to departure)
