




Ngāti Tama ki Te Tau Ihu Survey 2019 Frequently Asked Questions

1. Why are we doing an Education & Te Reo Survey?
 - Ngāti Tama received funding support from Te Mātāwai and The Ministry of Education to undertake scoping exercises of Te Reo and Education with Ngāti Tama iwi for the future development of iwi strategies.
 - We want to better understand the environments people live in, their aspirations, and the challenges they face.
 - The Ngāti Tama ki Te Tau Ihu Education & Te Reo me Ōna Tikanga Survey is an opportunity for whānau to have their experiences shared with us so that we are able to plan with whānau priorities and challenges in mind.
2. I am concerned about privacy and who will see my data?
 - To ensure that only registered Ngāti Tama ki Te Tau Ihu whānau complete the survey, and that each person completes it only once, we cross-reference at least two pieces of information with your Ngāti Tama ki Te Tau Ihu registration details on our database.
 - All responses will be made anonymous in the final report.
3. What will happen to all the information and will it be published?
 - The information gathered will be compiled and analysed by select people within Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu Trust and be used to draw themes and recommendations from the responses gathered.
 - A findings report will be made available to iwi members at the Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu Trust AGM, 25th April at Whakatū Marae.
4. I haven't updated my address with Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu Trust for a while – will my survey be accepted if the cross-check doesn't match the address on my survey?

- We understand that there are lots of whānau whose addresses may be different to what is on our database, and the Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu Trust Education and Te Reo me Ōna Tikanaga is also an opportunity for you to give us your current address details.
 - When survey data is collected, the address details are separated from the survey answers. If a survey address doesn't match our database, someone will follow-up with you at a later date to ensure we have up-to-date records for you.

5. How long is the Ngāti Tama ki Te Waipounamu Trust Education & Te Reo me Ōna Tikanga Survey open for?

- We undertook a series of workshops around Aotearoa with whānau, and from those questions we adjusted the questions based on feedback. We then made some changes launched the survey on 20 November 2019 and will be open until 18 December 2019.
